FACILITY:

Welcome! Our shows at VBEC provide beginning classes for all ages of riders, hunters, equitation, and jumpers. Overnight stabling, space for haul in trailers and trailer parking. Schooling available every Saturday before each show beginning at 12:00. Large open and covered show arenas and a large schooling arena. Lunging allowed.

AWARDS AND POINTS:

All divisions with 3 or more entries will be considered full and will receive full points towards division champion and reserve of the day. Classes with 2 or less entries, when cannot be combined with a suitable division, will be judged and awarded ribbons for each class. No champion or reserve champion award of the day.

SPECIAL CLASSES:

The Equitation Challenge class will be run at 3 heights with all riders being judged together. 2'1, 2'3, and 2'5. Jumping phase for all 3 heights and a flat phase with all riders.

DIVISIONS:

Pre maiden – 2' jumps, minimal fill, all canter
High crossrails – Set @ 2', minimal fill, all canter
Low crossrails – Set @ 1'7, minimal fill, all canter
Walk Trot Poles – Single pole course, Walk Trot only
Maiden – Set @ 2'1, No oxers
Limit – Set @ 2'5, Oxers
Jumpers – No fill, No oxers in .75 and .80

BEST CHILD RIDER

New this year, each show any rider can nominate to be considered for the Best Child Rider award. Show judges from each ring will be choosing the winner. Nomination fee is \$12.00 per rider/per show. Riders will be provided a colored arm band for the judges to recognize nominated riders.
